Program Information:

Youth Connections is a federal government-funded program to assist young people to achieve an education outcome of Year 12 or equivalent.

Youth Connections provides a safety net for young people who have disengaged or are at risk of disengaging from education, and offers support and services recognizing the role family and community play in a young person's well-being and development.

Eligibility:

- 13 to 19 years of age
- Are not employed
- Have not completed Year 12 or training at a certificate II level
- Are at risk of not completing Year 12 or a certificate II or making a successful transition to further education, training or employment.

Group programs

HYPA offers a range of group programs for eligible Youth Connections clients.

- School programs are designed based on the need within the school and are run weekly or fortnightly each term.
- Programs delivered from our Murray Bridge office are based on the needs of the clients including well-being and learning. These programs are designed for young people who are not attending main-stream education and require some life skills and well-being support.

How to Refer?

Through expressions of interest forms or a phone call to a Youth Connections Case Manager.

If you send us a referral we will contact you to discuss the young person.

Whenever possible the Case Manager will meet with the young person, conduct an assessment and, if the young person is eligible for the program, will arrange to meet with them on a regular basis.
